What you need:

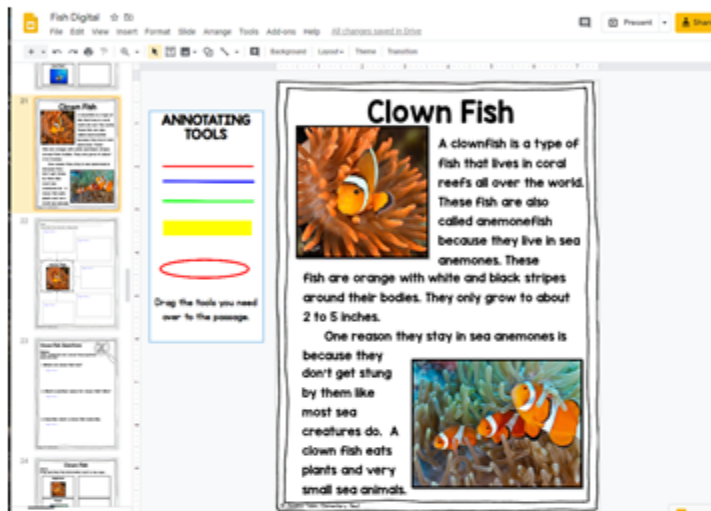
- A Google Classroom account

Lionfish are a fish found in the Pacific Ocean. They are beginning to grow in population in parts of the Atlantic Ocean and

Caribbean Sea, too. Lionfish grow about one foot in length. What makes them dangerous is their spines and their bodies.
