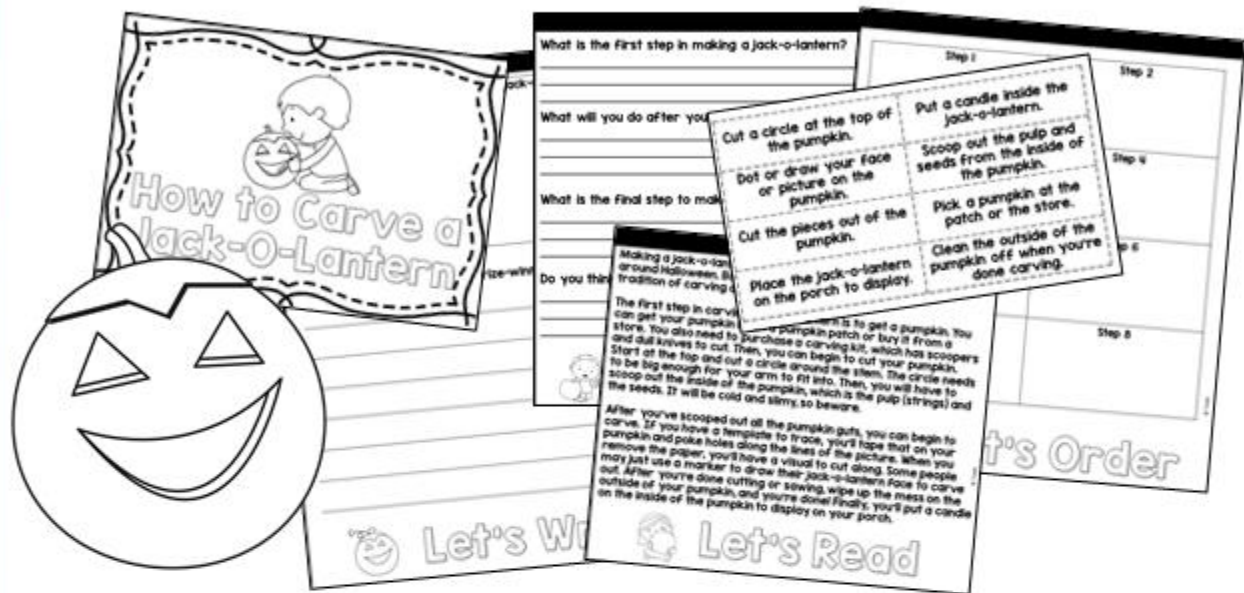
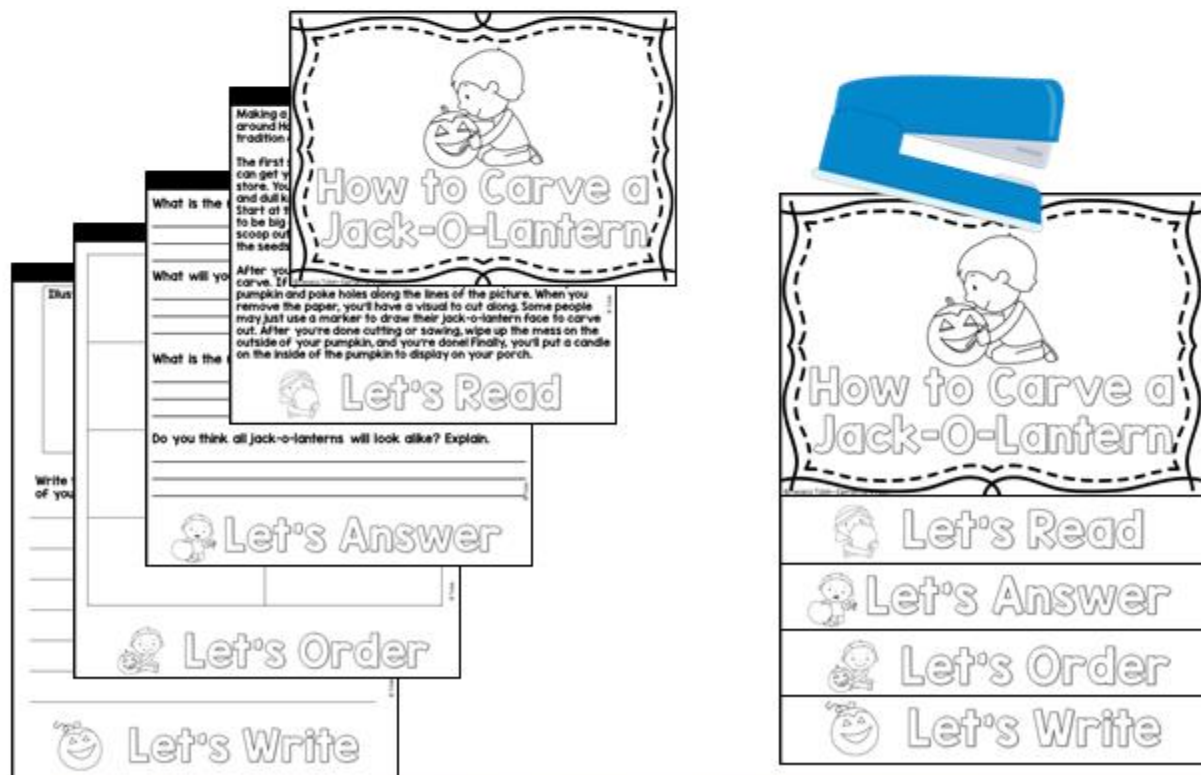


Building Your Craft...

Making a jack-o-lantern is a fun activity that many people do around Halloween. Both kids and adults enjoy this Halloween tradition of carving a pumpkin.

The first step in carving a jack-o-lantern is to get a pumpkin. You can get your pumpkin from a pumpkin patch or buy it from a store. You also need to get a pumpkin that has scoopers and dull knives. Start by cutting a hole in the top of the pumpkin. The circle needs to be big enough for you to scoop out the seeds.

After you cut the hole, you can begin to carve. You can use a marker to draw the lines of the picture. When you remove the top, you'll have a visual to cut along. Some people may just use a marker to draw their jack-o-lantern face to carve out. After you're done cutting or sawing, wipe up the mess on the outside of your pumpkin, and you're done! Finally, you'll put a candle on the inside of the pumpkin to display on your porch.
