This ELA unit provides resources to use while teaching the standard **L.K.I.c**, which states that students will be able to **"Understand and use question words (interrogatives)."**



## Using This Unit

Let's look at the structure of this unit.

### Lesson Plans

- There are 5 steps in the lesson plan of this unit. Depending on how long you have for mini lessons for Language, you can choose to do all 5 steps in one day or break it up over 2-4 days. I suggest at least 10 minutes for your daily lesson, then 15-20 minutes+ for practice time. Putting your activities together may take a week to complete.

### Graphic Organizers

- These can be used throughout the unit as you see fit. You can use them with your lessons if you need more or use them within their partner/independent time.

### Centers

- These can be used throughout the unit as you see fit, too. They can be used during group work, down time, or however they fit into your current ELA block structure.

### Assessment

- There is one informal assessment activity at the end of the lesson plan. When you're finished teaching your unit, use this assessment with your students.

# Mini Lessons

There is a lesson plan outline in this unit. There are five steps within this unit, which may take about a week to complete, depending on how long your ELA block is. Activities range from group work, partner activities, whole group lessons, and independent activities.

Understand and use question words (interrogative) (e.g., who, what, where, when, why, how).	
Vocabulary: question words Interrogative	Materials: Anchor chart Sentence strips Fold and strip Question word strips
<b>Activities to Teach:</b> <b>Step 1:</b> Teacher will create an anchor chart with students all about using question words or simply display the mini poster and discuss. <b>Step 2:</b> Students will participate in a Stand Up-Sit Down activity. The teacher reads sample questions and sentences. Students will stand up when they hear a question, and sit down when they hear a non-question. <b>Step 3:</b> The teacher will display a picture and a question word. Students will participate in a Mix-and-Match activity. They will mix up around the room, with a new partner, and create and share a question using the picture and question word. <b>Step 4:</b> Teacher will call on several students one at a time to stand up and answer a question. She will display a strip on the board (or simply write the question and ask for one student) to complete the question. <b>Step 5:</b> Students will create a fold and pop flip book. They will fold the book in half and write a question on the inside. They will write a sample question on the flip. If students aren't writing yet, they can copy the teachers sample question on the board.	
Suggested Group/Partner Centers: Center #1-3 in group	Suggested Independent Activities: Graphic Organizers
Assessment: Teacher will individually ask student questions.
