

 They can be used during group work, down time, or however they fit into your current ELA block structure.


Assessment


Lesson Plan Activities

There is a lesson plan outline in this unit. There are 5 steps within this unit, which may take about a week to complete, depending on how long your ELA block is.




Graphic Organizers
