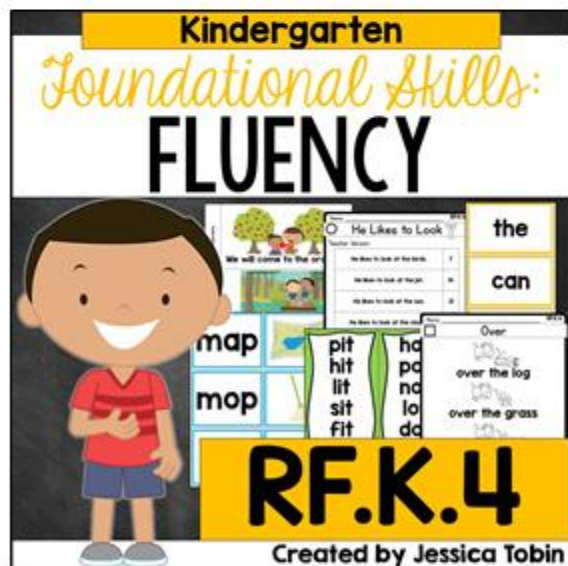


RF.K.4

This ELA unit provides resources to use while teaching the standard **RF.K.4**, which states that students will be able to **"Read emergent-reader texts with purpose and understanding."**



Using This Unit

Let's look at the structure of this unit.

This unit is different from the other RF.K units in the bundle. This unit does not have lessons and graphic organizers. This standard simply asks students to read emergent readers with purpose and understanding, so this unit can be supplemented within your year as you best see fit.

Emergent-Reader Texts

- There are 6 readers per level in this unit, plus 6 passages per level in this unit. These can be used during small group reading. They could also be used as assessment pieces to test students' fluency rates. Comprehension questions are also included to ensure understanding. Use these texts as you best see fit in your classroom.

Centers

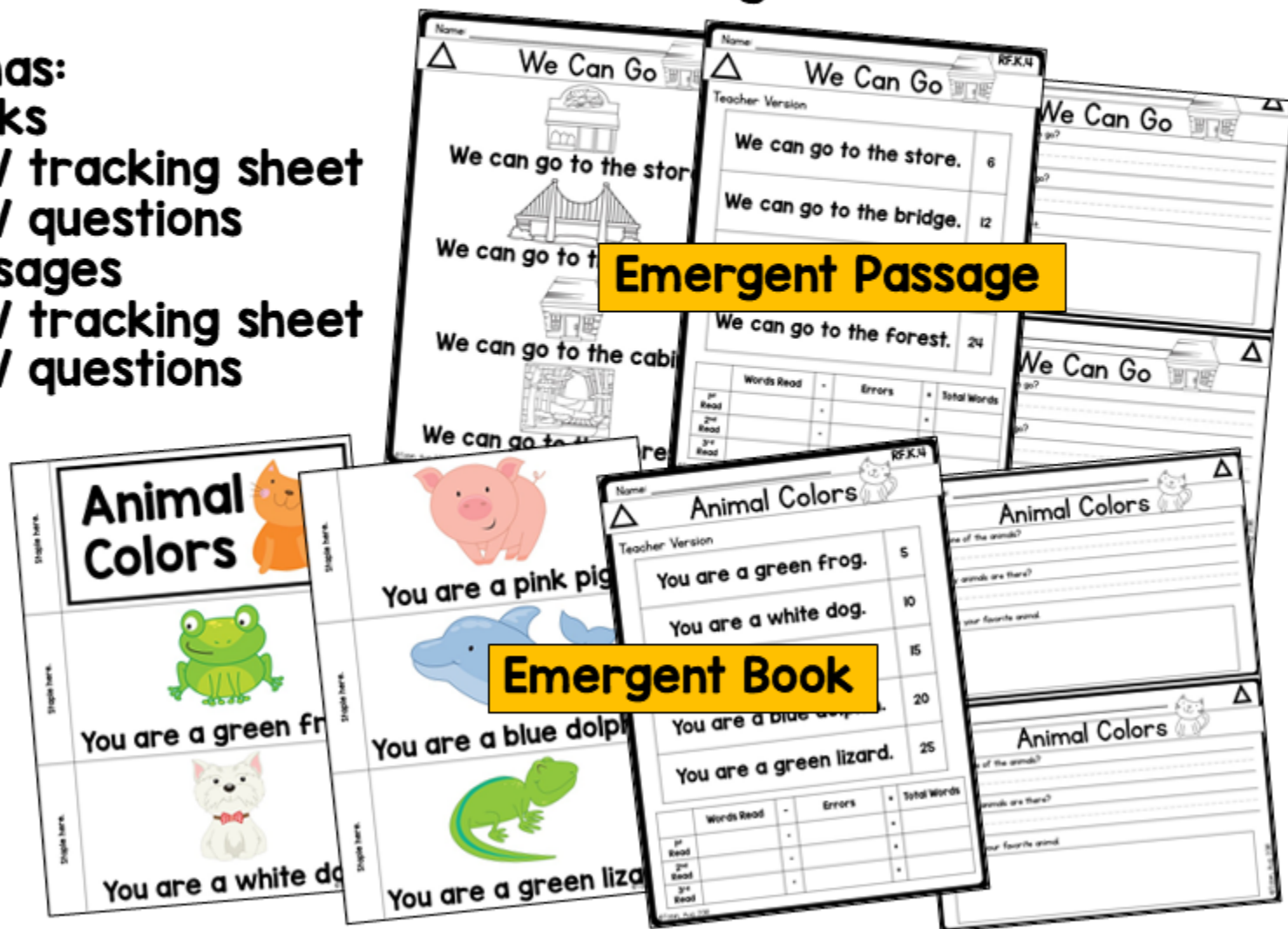
- Use these as practice throughout your year. Different group levels may be practicing different skills at different times. They can be used during group work, down time, or however they fit into your current ELA block structure. Cycle through for students to practice their fluency.

Emergent Readers

There are four levels within this unit. Levels 1-4 are similar to Levels aa-c in Guided Reading levels.

Each level has:


- 6 books
 - w/ tracking sheet
 - w/ questions
- 6 passages
 - w/ tracking sheet
 - w/ questions
