


Word Families

These 35 word family passages will help your students practice short vowel word families.



What's Included?

- 35 word family passages
- One multiple choice question for each passage
- One written question for each passage
- Space to write up to 4 words from that word family

- ad Word Family:** Dad was glad to see Tad and had been bad. That made Dad sad. Dad was glad that I was not bad. Dad told Tad he was not mad. Dad did not want him to be bad. *Illustration: A boy and a dog.*
- am Word Family:** I swam in the pond. When I saw a ram in the grass. I am too. I am home now. I will eat ham, jam, and yams with Pam. *Illustration: A boy and a dog.*
- at Word Family:** My cat is fat. She sat on the mat. She saw a rat and a bat, but did not go after them. My fat cat just sat on the mat. She let me pat her. *Illustration: A cat.*
- en Word Family:** Hen is pals with Fox. When Hen she sat in his den. They sat in for ten days. Then, Ben took Hen to a new pen. Fox still can to see Hen in her new pen. *Illustration: A hen and a fox.*
- et Word Family:** My pet got sick. I took her to the vet. The vet told me she had gotten wet. She got better and we met the vet again. This trip was much better. *Illustration: A dog.*
- id Word Family:** I played with the new kid. The new kid was Sid. We hid from our sisters. We did not want them to see us. Sid had his bugs in a jar. I lifted the lid to look in Sid's jar. *Illustration: A boy and a girl.*
- ill Word Family:** Jill and Bill went for a trip. They went up a hill. At the top, they lit a fire. They still talk of that trip up the hill. They will go back up the hill. *Illustration: A boy and a girl.*
- ing Word Family:** The owl sits on top of the tree. He uses his wing to cool the king. The owl is swinging. The king sings about his cool ring. The owl says it was a crazy thing to do. *Illustration: An owl.*
- ip Word Family:** I went to zip my jacket. I did a flip over the clip. I tripped and did a flip over the clip. I got a rip in my pants. I hurt my hip. I also bit my lip. I do not like that. *Illustration: A boy.*
- og Word Family:** At the farm, the dog and the hog are pals. They play by the log all day. They look for a frog. The dog and the hog jog until they found a frog. *Illustration: A dog and a hog.*
- ot Word Family:** We were camping out. It was a hot day. Mom was making a lot of soup in a pot. I was sitting on the cot. My brother got our dog Spot. Dad tied a knot in the rope. *Illustration: A boy and a dog.*
- up Word Family:** We got a new pup. He looks at my fish, Gup. He drinks water out of my cup. My pup even gets up on the back of my chair. My new pup is funny. *Illustration: A dog.*

Each passage includes a multiple-choice question and a written question, followed by space for writing up to 4 words from that word family.






